- To participate actively and serve at Grace Warabrook AM and PM including leading church, prayer, Kids Church etc.
- To attend a growth Group.

- A robust understanding of the Gospel and the Scriptures
- Formal theological training will be well regarded, either completed, in progress, or willingness to commence.
